## Evaluation activity



In different teams, school principals reflected about the implementation of the pilot at their schools identifying the positive elements, the ones that needed to be rethought or the ones they had questions about, and the negative ones.

## Evaluation activity highlights, Dissemination Event

### Some interesting outcomes were identified.

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*“Implement this pilot’s selection process”*

*“Select schools with vulnerable students”*

*“A two year school based training program”*

*“The participants, their training, attitudes and competences”*

*“Versatility of the fellow as a resource for the school”*

**Rethink**

*“... continue the project for at least one more year at the same schools”*

*“Incorporate training and teachers selection process to the system”*

*“Uncertainty about the continuity of the project... what’s happening next?”*

*“We need to value and reward the work done by the fellows somehow...”*

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*“If the project doesn’t continue”*

*“If our school isn’t part of a next version of this project”*

*“We need to learn to improve how to handle the pilot information in a next experience”*

*“More and deep information of the project to the school teachers in general”*


## Group reflection ¿Pilot continuity?



School principals and Government representatives reflected on how to take advantage and learnings of this experience to support vulnerable schools.

School principals made several statements regarding the need to improve teachers training and the importance of the Pilot continuity at their schools. On the other hand, the Government representatives made puntual questions regarding scale and mentioned the challenges of changing the education system.
